Friction (e.g., how friction works in our daily life) 3. Microorganisms (e.g., Fight between good bacteria and bad bacteria) <p>Instructions: Use your own drawings or printed images.</p> <p>Make it colorful and creative.</p> <p>The comic/story should have characters, a problem or concept, and a solution or explanation.</p> <p>Use simple language and scientific terms where appropriate. Example (for Respiration in Organisms): You could create a story where “Oxy the Oxygen Molecule” travels through the human body and explains how he helps release energy inside cells. You can show Oxy talking to lungs, blood, and cells in cartoon form.</p>
